Protect yourself and your accounts from scams and fraud.

Scammers are everywhere, and fraudsters are looking for innocent victims to fall prey to their schemes. Protect yourself and your accounts by being vigilant and

aware of these current scams: I

IRS phone scam - Scam artist calls your phone claiming to be from the IRS. They threaten you with legal action or intimidate you by saying you will be arrested unless you give them credit card or checking account information. HANG **UP IMMEDIATELY**. According to its official website, the IRS only does business by mail.

WINDOWS VIRUS WARNING! Identity Theft and Hacking Possibilties. 800-051-3723 fake phone number

a virus onto your computer. **NEVER CLICK THESE LINKS OR** CALL! If you do, shut off your computer immediately and NEVER give your debit card or account information with these

Email phishing - This scam

happens when you receive a suspicious email that requires you to click on a link to verify your account number. DON'T CLICK! Trash it right away. Usually these emails use bad grammar, have misspelled words and come from foreign email addresses

Microsoft phone scam - A so-called Microsoft agent calls your home to say that they've detected problems with your computer. **Do not** give them any information as the fraudster wants to gain access to your computer's I.P. address to hack your computer for secure information. HANG UP, PRONTO!

Computer virus warnings, software update scams -This scam happens when you are on your computer-most likely while surfing the internet. A pop-up window "Free" trials requiring card/account information - Any offer that requires you to enter your debit/credit card or checking account information is not FREE. You will be billed for recurring orders of the product (which you may never receive). PLEASE READ THE FINE PRINT!

Spring shred week is April 17 - 21.


Time to purge unwanted personal documents? Shred them in a safe and secure environment at our annual spring shred week, April 17-21.


Cities changes several fees to recoup costs, effective 3-1-17.

In order to keep up with the costs-of-doing-business, the credit union has changed the fees for some of our products and services. We have studied industry trends and compared our fee structure with those of other area financial institutions, including credit unions.

Debit card replacement fees--safeguard your card!

One of the biggest challenges we face is ordering replacement debit cards for members who have lost their cards. We can't emphasize enough the importance of protecting your card--a debit card is <u>the</u> access point to your checking account and should be guarded just like it were actual cash.

In order to promote safekeeping, responsibility and protective handling of debit cards, we are increasing the fees involved for replacing lost cards. This does NOT apply to expiring cards that are renewing.



When an expiring debit card renews, it must be activated within a 30-day period. If a member does not activate the card within that activation window, they will be required to call the credit union to activate the card. If we need to force activate it past that 30-day period, we reserve the right to fee the member \$2 to activate the card.

Free checks change

For members over 65 and those with Select Checking Accounts, the credit union will pay for ONE free box of checks

(150 quantity) per year for these members. Each free box of checks costs us approximately \$16.30 per order.

NEW--Fee Dispute Form

If you feel the credit union has assessed a fee in error to your account, we now require members to file a fee dispute with us. Please go to our website under the Online e-Sources menu and choose Downloadable Forms to file a Fee Dispute Form, or call us to send you a Fee Dispute Form.
